

11Days Cape Town + Kruger Park + Victoria Falls

Safari Overview: *This classic itinerary combines three of Southern Africa's iconic destinations. Start your holiday in the cosmopolitan city of Cape Town, known for an array of excursions from Table Mountain to the beautiful Winelands. Continue to the Kruger Park for a Big Five safari & fantastic big cat sightings and end at the majestic Victoria Falls. All game drives & transfers included.*

Day 1: Arrival and Overnight in Cape Town

You will be met at Cape Town Airport and transferred to your hotel in this beautiful city, within sight of Table Mountain. Check in and relax in your magnificent surroundings.

Day 2: sightseeing in Cape Town.

Today is free for independent sightseeing in Cape Town.

We recommend you purchase a day pass onboard the convenient Hop-Off Bus, which stops at all Cape Town's key sights and beaches. The "Red Route" bus stops at the Table Mountain base station, where you can buy a ticket to ascend by cable car and enjoy one of the world's most famous views. Continue to Camps Bay beach and the many attractions of the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront.

Day 3: Cape Town to Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve

Today we recommend an optional full day tour to the beautiful Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, where you may see baboons, ostrich and perhaps even dolphins or whales in season (July/November).

Your tour travels through Hout Bay and along spectacular Chapman's Peak Drive to the Cape Point peninsula, returning via Simons Town, Fish Hoek, Constantia and Kirstenbosch Gardens. This is a scenic tour of the whole Cape Peninsula, with the optional opportunity of visiting the penguin colony at Boulders Beach.

Day 4: At leisure to relax or explore more of the "Mother City" of Cape Town

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Many optional activities are available in this beautiful city. You can visit Robben Island where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned (advance booking essential in season) and explore the vibrant Victoria & Alfred Waterfront.

You can also take the Hop Off bus to visit world famous Kirstenbosch Gardens, enjoy a city tour or simply relax on golden Camps Bay Beach. Day tours can also be taken to the winelands of Stellenbosch & Franschhoek.

Day 5: Cape Town Airport and fly to Mpumalanga Airport and transfer to Kruger National Park

Transfer to Cape Town Airport for your onward flight.

You will be met at Mpumalanga Airport and transferred 3-hours to your game lodge in the world famous Kruger National Park.

After checking in, enjoy a thrilling game drive in an open-top vehicle accompanied by a lodge ranger. Game viewing opportunities should present themselves almost immediately in this vast wildlife wilderness. Hopefully you will see several species of antelope, zebra, wildebeest and maybe even giraffe - as well as several of the Big Five - before dining under the stars in the atmosphere that only the African bushveld can provide.

Day 6: Full day in Kruger National Park

Rise at dawn to take advantage of the best game viewing conditions of the day, as you enjoy an open-top game viewing drive with a lodge ranger in the world famous Kruger National Park.

Explore some of this vast game sanctuary that is the size of Wales, offering magnificent game viewing opportunities and the highest concentration of lion in the whole of Africa. Hope to see several of the Big Five today - lion, elephant, buffalo, leopard and rhino - as well as many other species before returning to your lodge for breakfast.

The rest of the morning is free to relax by the swimming pool or enjoy bird watching at the lodge, before setting out again in the late afternoon for another game drive. With nearly 150 different species of mammals and over 100 species of reptiles in the Kruger National Park, you can hope to see cheetah, giraffe, hippo, kudu, crocodiles, sable antelope, waterbuck, warthogs, baboons, wild dogs and many other interesting animals. With over 500 different bird species including eagles, kingfishers, vultures and storks, outstanding bird watching is also guaranteed.

After a beautiful African sunset, enjoy the balmy evening and pristine stars of the Milky Way as you have never seen them before – as well as the spectacular Southern Cross.

Day 7: Kruger National Park and Scenic Panorama Route

After a final early morning game drive in the Kruger National Park, transfer 3-hours to your hotel on the scenic Panorama Route.

There are many activities available in this region, including the elephant sanctuary in Hazyview and the chimpanzee sanctuary in Nelspruit. Also day tours of the Panorama Route, several golf courses and many beautiful walks, with outstanding bird watching

Day 8: Mpumalanga Airport and fly to Zambia via Livingstone Airport

Transfer to Mpumalanga Airport for your onward flight.

You will be met at Livingstone Airport and transferred to your hotel on the banks of the Zambezi River, near the mighty Victoria Falls.

Check in, settle in and relax whilst you catch your first glimpses of the magnificent Smoke That Thunders first discovered by Dr. David Livingstone and still one of the greatest natural wonders of the world. The flow of water over the Victoria Falls is greatest from February to June following the summer rains and is a magnificent sight.

Please note that the Zambian side of the falls dries up in October and November, when it is better to visit the Zimbabwean side.

Day 9: Full Day at Victoria Falls

Today we recommend exploring on foot the mighty Victoria Falls and its rainforest, which offers magnificent views. Afterwards you can participate in other optional activities such as a helicopter flight over the falls or an elephant interaction.

In the late afternoon we suggest an optional Sunset Cruise on the Zambezi River where you may see hippos, crocodiles and abundant bird life.

Note: We suggest you take your own raincoat for walking in the rainforest, as those on hire are well used. There is also the option of crossing over to the Zimbabwean side of the falls for postcard views (passport and uni-visa required). This is essential in the dry water season.

Day 10: At leisure to relax at your hotel near the magnificent Victoria Falls

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Many optional activities are on offer, such as a helicopter flight over the falls, an elephant-back safari or a game drive in Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park.

Adrenalin seekers can participate in many adventure activities such as canoeing in the gentler rapids above the falls, abseiling or white water rafting in the turbulent gorge below the falls (grade 5), or bungee jumping from Victoria Falls Bridge.

You can also take an excursion to view the Victoria Falls from the Zimbabwean side (passport and univisa required).

Day 11: Livingstone airport and depart

Transfer to Livingstone Airport for your flight home.
